The treated problems are current and varied - they concern subjects like communications, transport, telegraph messages, roads, using of electricity, inventions in physics, posts, aeronautics, knowledge of chemistry, economics, astronomy, mathematics, geology, meteorology, photography etc. The names of Nuton, Kopernik, Stephanson and also the Bulgarian scientists Petar Beron and Nikolai Toshkovich became very popular.
