Обработката на постъпилия в музея архив продължава, като класифицираните до момента материали дават основание да се направи изводът, че Димитър Савов е притежавал силно чувство на историчност и отговорност пред поколенията. И в това си качество той е приучил и възпитал и своите наследници, които са ги опазили през десетилетията. Днес те са богатство за родния им град, разкривайки важна информация за живота на фондообразователя, както и за местната власт, обществените дела и институции в Пирдоп и региона.

NEW DOCUMENTS IN THE COLLECTION OF THE "LUKANOV'S HOUSE" MUSEUM – PIRDOP REGARDING DIMITAR SAVOV - A REBEL AND THE FIRST MAYOR OF THE TOWN AFTER THE LIBERATION

Abstract

In 2012 citizens of the town of Pirdop donated to the "Lukanov's House" Museum a considerable volume of documents owned by three generations of the famous Savovs: the rebel and first mayor of Pirdop after the Liberation Dimitar Savov, his son - the lawyer Simeon Savov and the actress Dimitrina Simeonova Savova. A review and evaluation of the materials revealing the unknown aspects of Dimitar Savov's life are carried out.

Documents of particular value are the Rules of the Constituent Assembly (1879), in which he was a deputy of Law, as well as others from the same time such as: a personal copy of the Rules belonging to the second of the four MPs from Pirdop – Luka H. Pavlov; his letter from 1880 to his fellow citizens about the Speech from the Throne of the royal prince Alexander Batenberg at the opening of the Second Regular National Assembly; acts of Pirdop Municipality for giving and accepting the mayoral institution from the beginning of 1895, etc.

Some of Dimitar Savov's personal documents are more distinctive: reports on his work as a supervisor of the land registers in Sofia region and his activity as a superintendent in the "Black mosque" prison; his arrest on charges of helping those convicted in the murder of minister Hristo Belchev; original photographs of rebels from Pirdop, evidence of mayors of municipalities from the region about Dimitar Savov, etc.
